C/11/0193	12 <sup>th</sup> Feb 2011	Union Farm, Southwold Road, Bulcamp, Blythburgh	Erection of a 5kW wind turbine and 4kW PV system

Cllr Mackley presented the view of the planning group: This application was about power generation at Union Farm. There was no problem foreseen with the PV panels. The turbine position means it should not effect sight lines as it is shielded by trees. It was also expressed that the impact on wildlife would be negligible. Its location was not on heathland but was in an AONB but there are no restrictions on placing turbine in such areas.

There followed a debate about the location of the turbine and that it would be visible from the south. There was also concern this was setting a precedent. After further debate the Chair put this to a vote. The outcome was 4 to 1 Councillors having no objection to this application.

Proposal – Clerk to contact SCDC stating 4 to 1 majority of no objection to this application. Clerk also to requested a line of trees be planted at the southern edge of the property
