11/122. Quotation for Playsite Fence.

Clerk stated requests had been made for quotations from a number of fence erecting companies and after two weeks only one had responded. The quotation received was to supply and erect 19.5m of 1650mm high close board fencing with 150mm concrete gravel boards. Price £980.00. Cllr DeThabrew stated he has spoken to people in this field and this was a good price. Chair asked if this fitted with the council financial regulations. Clerk responded that it did.
